Therefore, in order to assure our children a full integrated help, we started to provide our schools and centers with pediatric infirmaries and health centers to take care of our students and their health problems. Only this way we feel confident that all needs of children are supported.

Directly inside problematic areas: Project for a Mobile Pediatric Unit in Brazil



The best way to respond to many needs of different communities is having a "mobile know-how" promoting health of children in poor urban areas of Brazil. This is a way to respond to the general prerequisite of a Mobile Unit to intervene directly inside favelas in different parts of Brazil. Therefore, the Mobile Child Unit (MCU) is totally equipped to host labs for the monitoring and care of children. It will move around Brazil according to projected "road plans" with cooperating communities. Here, the MCU will stay for a limited time but enough to assess local needs, to collect data, and to start health programs with the community.
